By the time you will see this my friends, we will be roughly halfway along the way towards the celebration of resurrected life that comes with Easter and the resurrection of our Lord Jesus. And so as you travel this road...

Grace and peace be to you from our God and Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. May these together with the Holy Spirit strengthen, preserve and keep you now unto the day of your final rest and resurrection.

In this season where the themes revolve around sparse desolation, what are you discovering in you that is slowly withering away as you are practicing the disciplines of denial that God gifts us for our good? What habits in you are being slowly broken down to be replaced by those which you are discovering to be more life giving and blessed?

Are you finding any new disciplines that prior to taking them on, they seemed too difficult to put into place and yet now a bit further down the road, you are beginning to see them as "light(er)" and "easy(er)"? How have you noticed God accompanying you along this Lenten road?

Some of you will no doubt be more likely just getting started on your Lenten journey, while many of you crossed well into the desolation back on Ash Wednesday. Regardless of where you are in your Lenten disciplines, I encourage you to use this time well and wisely. Clear some space out of a cluttered soul... (which for me is also about taking some steps toward



clearing some things out of my cluttered spaces) Enter into a new season of desolation and discover anew the God who meets us in these lonely spaces as a source of fresh insight, life and hope!

It is in these deserted places that we begin to know the "Be still and know that I am God" and the "anyone who loses their life for my sake will find it" that Jesus brings into our life and makes true in truly surprising ways.

It turns out that we do in fact grow in the desert and in the desolate places that exist between us and God. It turns out that God meets us there and faithfully leads us through to the promised land of trust and faith in Him forsaking the allure of all others who clamor for our attention and allegiance.


