A WORD FROM THE

Returning to Acts
(As in the book... as in the Acts of the Apostles!)

Dearest friends.

I make to you an invitation. I invite you to come to the Sunday worship of Wooden Cross beginning in September where we will be walking week by week through the Book of Acts as our focus in worship. This book is the never-old, always-renewing account of:

- How God forms and creates His church
- How the Spirit calls, creates, grows and develops a people
- How the Apostolic teaching of Jesus Christ as Lord, Savior, and One of the Persons of God is the heart of being this church
- ▶ How God calls forth leaders for the sake of His church

... and more

There are other books of the Bible that speak to these points as well. As we journey through Acts, I'd expect we will turn to some of these along the way to flesh out what all the Holy Spirit is teaching us in the Word of God for us. Focusing on Acts though, I'd suggest this book is a most highly concentrated "dose" of what God has conveyed on these matters of what makes and sustain his church and what defines the church's callings into life and ministry.

I expect this will be fun and at the same time timely given all the realities arrayed before Christians today

and Wooden Cross as well. Spending time listening to God on these vital matters will yield fruit for Scripture reminds us that the Word of God never returns an empty yield.

So come... be present to God... be present with one another. Encourage and support. Learn and love and together let us return to God's Word of the Acts of the Apostles and notice God's Holy Spirit moving and working among us as well.

One encouragement though... come in person if at all possible. One piece you will see clearly in Acts, is how God's Spirit is always working to draw people together not just in mind and spirit, but physically as well. He gave us physical bodies and then brings these together into one body of Christ as His people share their lives together. Being proximate to one another seems to matter greatly to God. So if you can... come in person and be available to one another. Of course as always, the online streaming is useful to give people a way to connect in virtually, I'd just encourage folks to

CHRISTIAN RESPONSE RECYCLING

Reminder that we are now taking polystyrene (Styrofoam) recycling to the Shoreline Transfer Station. Blocks or sheets must be clean, dry, and empty. No packing peanuts. No food, liquid, food packaging, stickers, or tape. They do not take foam food meat trays, or the softer white and/or black foam blocks as is increasingly being used in packaging. Anything else we must sort and put in the church garbage can so please do not bring those.

As many of their clients live in small homes with limited storage they ask that there are no large bulk items donated such as Costco size bags of rice, Costco multi-packs are okay.


HOLY GUACAMOLE-FIESTA & FUNDRAISER!

"God's work. Our hands." is an extension of the work you do every day to make your community a better place. We look forward to working together on September 7! Go in peace. Serve the Lord!


