"I have been crucified with Christ." —Galatians 2:20 Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The crucifixion is upon us. I'd invite you to not gloss too quickly over this reality, for it conveys truth in several different ways.

We live in a death-averse culture where much of our energy gets expended in avoiding death or at least attempting to do so. But Jesus' crucifixion **is upon us**. There is no avoiding that his death is taken on for us... for all those who sin and fall short of God's glory. To avoid it is to completely miss the significance of Jesus Passion (suffering) and death. For it is by witness of Scripture that "by his stripes we are healed."

Through our enmity with God we are alike to those whose voices called "crucify" and who stood by and bore witness to Jesus giving his all in faithful surrender to the "Cup" he had prayed to avoid, and yet surrendered to ultimately as the "will that was to be done" that took him to the cross. His surrender is necessitated by us all who continue to insist upon our "right to ourselves" which is a way to discuss the root beneath all sin. This is our root and it is because of this root that Jesus came to give himself to heal and mend.

Come friends and sit with me a while at the foot of the cross for our Lord there is crucified and this crucifixion IS upon us all.

Paul in Galatians captures something that can also be oft overlooked. It is something deeper than simply reflecting upon the crucifixion and the cause behind it... for to dwell exclusively there is to miss what is actually happening... who all is dying there. For there is something profound happening that should we simply think of ourselves as "witnesses" then we are missing who is fully dying in that moment.

"I have been crucified with Christ," Paul says.

The full implication of this short sentence is that it is not JUST Jesus dying on the cross... It is you and it is me too. WE die there! Our insistence to have a "right to ourselves" dies there. The gift of the cross might be well described as not only a new life, but first it is a death... your death, my death... all gifted to us through the death of Christ. His crucifixion IS upon us... it permeates our being and is imparted to us by God through faith in Christ. We die there and as Luther later described our entire life is to be lived in a rhythm of "taking on the cross of Christ and dying daily to sin and
